MICHELE COUSIN-HARTMANN**



Matteo is 7 years old, and was born with Achondroplasia, a common type of dwarfism. Many complications are associated with this condition, with lumbar kyphosis being one of them. After consulting with several orthopaedic surgeons, and bracing him for well over a year (with little to no improvement), we learned about hippotherapy. Within a few months we started noticing Matteo was getting stronger, and the curvature of his lower back was getting gradually less noticeable. Our observations were later confirmed with X-rays that indicated an improvement in the kyphosis, and at every 6-month reevaluation, the images show either stability or improvement, to the point his main orthopaedic surgeon is not sure he will ever need surgery.


